## Vets Corner - Lungworm Alert!!

*Aniostrostrongylus Vasorum*, commonly known as lungworm is a potentially life-threatening nematode of dogs.

In the past year or two it has been reported that the level of infection appears to be on the increase. In the UK this parasite has traditionally only been found in isolated hotspots, however in recent years there has been an emergency of clinical cases across the UK.

**Clinical Presentation:** Most common in young dogs, although all ages can be affected. Typically the clinical signs include coughing or respiratory signs, for example, exercise intolerance. But not all cases present in this way, ongoing postoperative haemorrhage may also be a sign. A recent survey indicated that about 7% of dogs found to be infected showed no clinical signs at all, demonstrating that this can remain a hidden risk. It is important to note that it is not only slug and snail eaters that are at risk because intermediate hosts may be accidentally ingested (in food or water bowls or when attached to treats or toys).

**Treatment:** Lungworm can be fatal. A spot-on is now licensed for the treatment, but it is a prescription only medicine, available through your veterinary practice. The treatment is simple and involves routine monthly use.

If you need any further information about Lungworm then the best approach is to speak to your Veterinary surgeon, who can advice about the risk level in your area.
