CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/PREFERENCE IN THE DRAW**

Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes will be reported to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The Society reserves the right to refuse entry.
2. All **entries must be completed clearly, please print**, as the society **will return any ineligible entries**, which may result in missing the draw.
3. Preference in the draw will be given to owners who are fully paid members which have gained qualifying awards, then non-members dogs with awards above, members dogs with other awards, members dogs, then non-members dogs..
4. All persons attending must consider themselves under the control of the officials at all times.
5. All dogs must be registered at the Kennel Club in the name of the owner(s). Signature on the entry form is confirmation that the dog is free from and has not suffered from, or been exposed to, any contagious or infectious disease within 21 days of the Trial. **NO BITCHES IN SEASON.**
6. The Committee wish it to be known that dogs likely to **whine bark or be unsteady** on driven or walked up game **SHOULD NOT BE ENTERED.**
7. Dogs entered must have experience of retrieving game in the shooting field.
8. Substitution of entries is allowed up to 48 hours of the trial being run. Provided it is eligible and, where preference in the draw is held, it has the necessary qualifications.
9. No person may handle more than one dog unless the stake is under-subscribed.
10. Anyone having accepted a run in a Stake, then withdrawing within seven days of the trial being run, will, forfeit the whole of the entry fee, unless the dog has qualified out of Novice Stakes after the entries have closed or on production of a Veterinary Certificate, or a bitch is in season.
11. Applicants who do not enclose a **STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** to cover **EACH DRAW** applied for will not receive a copy of that draw.
12. Any competitor **NOT PRESENT AT THE MEET** when the **CHIEF STEWARD** announces the trial has commenced will forfeit their place to the reserve and may not demand a run there after regardless of the circumstance.
13. If a dog is jointly owned, **both owners must be members of the club.**

No modification will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the Kennel Club by advertisement in the journals if time permits before the closing of entries.

Please note: The K.C. Regulations J11 & J12 re objections and disqualifications.

GUIDELINES FOR GIVING WATER AT FIELD TRIALS

1. After a trial has been officially declared to have started, handlers shall not administer water to their dogs other than by offering the dog water in a bowl or from a natural source such as a stream.
2. In particular, handlers should not grasp or roughly hold their dogs nor shall they either squirt water from a plastic bottle or similar container in the dog's face or hold the dog to force the water down the dog's throat.
3. If the handler is concerned that their dog requires water during a run then he shall in the first instance ask the judge for permission and must neither hold the dog nor force water into the dog's face.

Please Note: It is due to the generosity of the landowners, guns and keepers that we are able to hold trials. Please ensure that your dog has had the necessary experience on game and that it will be steady and quiet during the drives.

All competitors should have read the K.C Field Trial Rules and Regulations.
