**FIELD TRIAL**  
**RULES AND REGULATIONS: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY/PREFERENCE IN THE DRAW**

Should conditions so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes will be reported to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Society may reserve to itself the right to refuse any entry.
3. Substitution of entries is allowed up to 48 hours of the trial being run. Provided it is eligible and where preference in the draw is held, it has the necessary qualifications.
4. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
6. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the chief steward and the host.
7. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
9. In order to qualify for members entry fee the handler must be a fully paid up member of the Isle of Wight Gundog Club.

**DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS**

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

**WELFARE OF DOGS**

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Please Note: It is due to the generosity of the landowners, guns and keepers that we are able to hold trials. Please ensure that your dog has had the necessary experience on game and that it will be steady and quiet during the drives. All competitors should have read the K.C. Field Trial Rules and Regulations.
